When is Minimum Day?

Minimum day is every Thursday for 1-6 grades, except during track change. Track change can be any day, but is most often on Friday. When track change is not on a Thursday, Thursday will be a normal day. We can only have one minimum day a week. Minimum days dismiss at 1:00.

When does the school day begin and end?

1-6 grades begin at 8:50 every morning and end at 3:30, except for minimum days which end at 1:00. (please see question When is Minimum Day?) AM Kindergarten begins at 8:50 and ends at 12:10, PM Kindergarten begins at 12:10 and ends at 3:30. PM Kindergarten are not effected by Minimum Day

When does the school year begin and end?

Monterey is a year-round 4 track school. A, B, and C tracks began on July 3rd, 2008. D track began on August 4th, 2008. A track will end on May 27, 2009, and B, C, and D tracks will end on June 26, 2009.

Can I change tracks?

At this time tracks are full and can only be changed when available on a first come first serve basis.

How many grades do we have on each track?

We have one of each grade per track for K-5, except for B track K-5 which is bilingual. All four 6th grade classes are on D track.

Do we have Special Ed?

We have one K-6 Special Ed class and a Resource Specialist.

Do we have Tutoring?

Tutoring will be available later in the year. The teacher will select students on an assessment basis.

What is the CAPS/Sunrise program?

CAPS is an after school programs for K-6 students. Sunrise is a before school program for K-6 students. They have planned activities that will support academic growth and provide fun also.

What do I do to put my child in the afternoon CAPS program?

Afternoon CAPS parents must first attend an informational meeting before students can attend. The meeting will be held on Wednesdays at 4:00, and the students will start CAPS on the following Monday.

Is there an Athletic program?

Only in the afternoon CAPS program.
